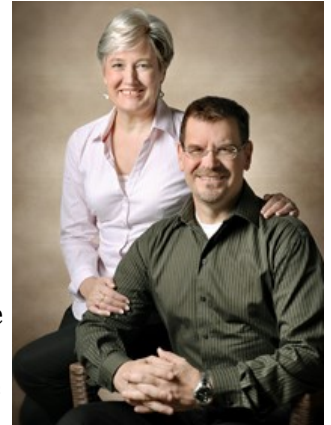


# *Merry Hearts and Dry Bones*

In July 2013 David accepted the appointment of SE Regional Team Leader with the Western Pennsylvania District and in 2017 became the District Superintendent.
