Revamp the Camp

Ulyanovsk, Russia

One of the ministry initiatives of the WPA-Russia Connection ministry partnership is to assist Russian partner organization camps to fulfill their mission and vision. This camp, a former communist propaganda camp for children in the mountains, is owned and operated by the Association of Missionary Churches of Evangelical Christians (AMCEC). Sergey Guts is the president of AMCEC and the pastor of a church in Ulyanovsk, Russia, and has ministered in our district several times, including Kids Mission Impact.

Current ministries of the camp:

- ◆ Children's summer camp
- ◆ Youth conferences
- ◆ Residential substance abuse recovery program for men during the fall, winter and spring months.

The desire is to expand these ministries and to add opportunities for:

- Family camps
- Leadership development retreats for church leaders
- Missions conferences
- Missionary training

The vision is to see this camp function throughout the entire year.

While much work needs to be done at the camp, the biggest needs exist in the dining hall and dormitory building, two significant buildings for children's camp ministry. The children need a safe, warm, dry place to eat, sleep and interact.

Project Needs:

- * New windows @ \$300 per window - 15 for the dormitory and 7 for the dining hall. Total cost for windows = \$6,600.
- * New roof for both buildings. Cost is unknown at this time.
